GAME PLAY UPDATE

As you likely heard at the end of last year the Canadian Curling Association will be releasing changes to the Rules of Curling for General Play. I heard rumours of two changes last spring that could have a significant effect on how some of us play the game.

The first was that changes would be made to the release point for stick curlers; they would have to release the stone before their feet crossed the tee line. This would have brought Canada in line with the World Curling Federation. I am pleased to say this change is not going to happen.

The other and more significant change will move us from a four guard rule to a five guard rule. This change is being made and will be adopted throughout our club. I have touched base with a few other clubs in the area and there isn't a consensus in handling this change. Some clubs are making the change and some aren't, and even worse, one club is making the change for only one of their leagues. I suspect/hope that all clubs will have made the change within the next couple of years.

Concerns have been expressed that the five guard rule may slow down the game. This may or may not be true. What I do know is that all of us could improve in our speed of play. A curling etiquette document should be published on our web page fairly soon. Take a look at it, it covers speed of play. One thing I

would like to see everyone do this year is go out onto the ice a few minutes ahead of the game so the game can start promptly at the scheduled time. That means you will already have shaken hands, decided which team throws first stone and cooled your slider foot. It also means the skips will be in position at the other end of the ice.
