Q: How did you get into this sport?

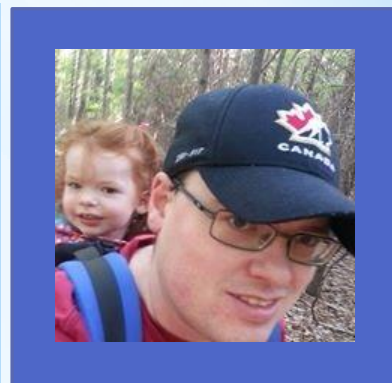

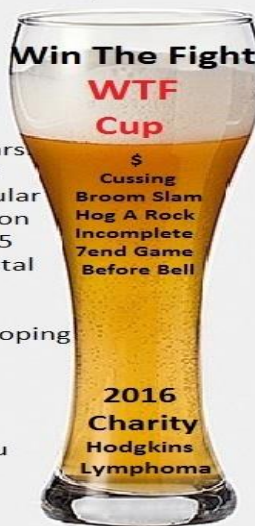
