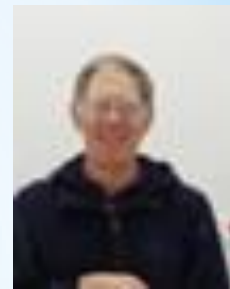

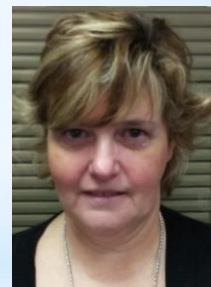

There are 64 rinks in the Open Division and 32 rinks in the Seniors' Division (55 years of age and over). Games are held in 9 different clubs. Our objective is to promote women's curling. “How do I find a spare?”

Spares lists have been provided to the conveners from our registration director. These lists are posted under the MEMBERS tab of our website manotickcurling.com. Speak to your convener for access. Reminder MCC membership, league, or phone listings that are available on the club website or are issued by the club or any of its representatives such as league conveners, are for club and curling related use only.



“How can I get 8 ends in before the bell rings?”



Curling Canada says that these are the top 5 (FIVE) tips to help **YOU** get your 8 ends (15min MAX/end) in before the bell goes:

1. Be on the ice five minutes EARLY
2. Thrower should be ready to go When the Skip takes control
3. Practice non-democratic curling - Input about strategy at every turn is very rarely appreciated or productive.
4. Do not pull out the oppositions' stones - This is an archaic and dangerous “courtesy” that has been on its way out for a long time
5. Don't worry about the rocks being in order in the corner - That's right... who cares.

“What are the best practices to keep the ice clean?”



There's over 400 of us curling in our club this year. Each member is responsible for the 'well being' of our ice. Here's how YOU can contribute:

- Keep your KNEES and HANDS off the ice - yeah we all like to gloat over our lucky shots, BEST to restrict contact to your curling shoes on the ice
- Remove all OUTSIDE footwear in the Lobby before entering the Minto Lounge
- Take your curling gear and shoes home for a regular cleaning - grass, lint, dander like to stick to our clothing and its those 'bits' that cause those infamous 'picks'
