SUNDAY MORNING YOUTH PROGRAM - LITTLE ROCKS & BANTAM: Chris Innes



This year the youth program grew from 89 youth to 114 and had 32 dedicated instructors. The youth programs runs from 8:45 to 5:30 every Sunday. Special thanks to Coach Ian Bambrough. Ian is in grade 11 and has clocked over 125 volunteer hours this year helping our program. We sent at least 29 Little Rock teams to 15 events including: Rideau, Carleton Heights, Manotick, Navan, North Grenville, Navy, Metcalfe, City View, Carleton Place, Prescott, Kingston, Richmond Bunny Spiel, Huntley, RCMP and Glenmore. We sent 4 Little Rock teams to the Little Rock zones winning the B side and will be heading the Little Rock Championship shortly. We hosted a Little Rock spiel, a Bantam spiel and the Little Rock zones. We also ran a "Teach your parent to curl" day where the youth taught the lesson to their parents and then played a game against them. We were invited, for the 4th year in a row, to setup and run a curling display for the Governor General at Rideau Hall where in the range of 8,000 visitors visited Rideau Hall for the day. We had 5 teams in the Ottawa Youth

Curling League (OYCL) representing Manotick (Daigle, Deschenes, Madden, Burke and Maynard). We had a few other players sprinkled on other teams. Our Bantam teams were very busy this year too! Team Daigle, finished 3rd in the OJCT U18 Rocktoberfest in Coldwater and was runner-up in the U16 division of the Tim Caverly bonspiel in Montreal. They also just claimed the B-side championship in the Manotick Mens League and played in the U18 Provincial Qualifier. Team Deschenes qualified for U18 Provincials. Team Sutherland participated in many U18 and U21 events. They finished 1st in one U18 event and 2nd in eight other events including placing 2nd in the U21 championship. They finished 4th in the U18 category and 13th in the U21 category in the Ontario Junior Curling tour. Team Madden, won the recreational division in Perth and Richmond as well as going undefeated in their division on the OYCL. On the coaching side, one of our coaches, Paul Madden, won the Senior Men's Provincials and will be representing Ontario at the Nationals. Another fun year with the youth program.
