KAROL BILYJ MEMORIAL ISLAND BONSPIEL

By now, most of our members have learned of Karol Bilyj's passing in June. Karol has been a fixture at the Manotick Curling Center for over 4 decades. Years ago, he started our youth curling program and personally instructed hundreds of young people over the years. His legacy can be seen in the national champion banners that hang proudly in our Club. He initiated the day-time senior leagues that now keep our club full of enthusiastic curlers every day. As a former Club President and all-round do-everything member, he was the first inductee to the MCC Wall of Fame. Karol was a co-founder of the Ottawa Valley Senior Men's Competitive Curling League, entering the first Manotick team in 1993. Karol was considered a friend in virtually every curling club in Ottawa and the Valley.

In honor of the many years of service and comradeship that he brought to us, the Board of Directors, with the approval of Karol's wife Olga, decided to rename our premier senior invitational spiel to The Karol Bilyj Memorial Island Bonspiel.

Did you know that as a member of the Ottawa Valley Curling Association (OVCA) we have access to curling grants? The OVCA has designed their grants to assist MCC and its members in numerous ways. These grants are funded from events such as the recent Brier or the upcoming Roar of the Rings.

This year the OVCA grants include:

- The Adult Training Program Grant is designed for clubs that want to implement a learn-to-curl program.
- The Energy Savings Project Grant is designed to assist curling clubs in energy saving projects.
- OVCA Capital Grants are used to help increase clubs accessibility for the differently abled and purchase youth curling rocks.
- The OVCA League Grant is designed to help clubs offset the cost of renting ice for their operations.
- The OVCA Team Grant assists teams that have qualified for provincial/national and international championship tournaments.
