

### Introducing the Manotick Curling Club GRAND SPIEL By Merv McBride



#### **BRANCH GOVERNOR GENERALS**

History: First played in 1874 with games lasting 21 ends.

Eligibility: The two teams must be members of the same club and be affiliated with the Canadian Branch.

Team Registration: \$200 per double rink entry from affiliated clubs with a limit of one entry per club. Please let bob.macgregor@Xplornet.com know it you plan to enter. If more than one entry from MCC must determine who will represent club.
